Epson Connect web site (www.epsonconnect.com) currently supports both encrypted access (https:// \sim) and unencrypted access (http:// \sim). "TLS1.0", "TLS1.1" and "TLS1.2" are supported for encrypted access.

However, due to security vulnerabilities have been reported recent years, "TLS1.0" and "TLS1.1" will no longer be supported in Epson Connect web site.

And we will ensure that unencrypted access is automatically redirected to encrypted access.

By this change, it is no longer possible to access to Epson Connect web site from operating system or browser which does not support "TLS1.2".

Please make sure that operating system and browser you are currently using supports "TLS1.2".
